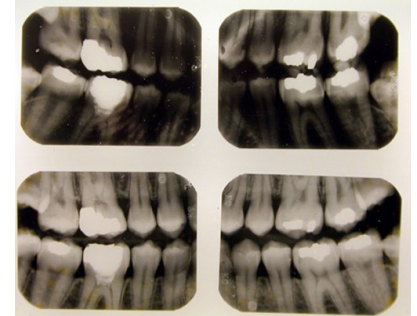


Basic Training for the Medicolegal Death Investigator - 2017

Description

This program is designed by medicolegal death investigators to familiarize the participant with the operations of a death investigation system and the role of the medicolegal death investigator. Topics have been chosen that will cover the basics and provide some advanced training and lab work for individuals already working in the field.

Medical examiners, coroners, medicolegal death investigators, all levels of health care professionals, law enforcement personnel, forensic technicians, investigators, detectives, prosecutors, and emergency medical personnel.
